Pastor: The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in loving-kindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. Know surely, your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.

People: Thanks be to God. Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen!
