OUTLINE

Text: John 10:22-42

- I. Back in Jerusalem. Back among his enemies.
- II. Jesus condemns them. They were going to trap him, but Jesus again turns the tables on them.
- III. What does it mean to be one of His sheep? In verses 27-29 there is one of the great promises of Christ. The sheep of Christ hear the voice of the Shepherd and they follow him. The heart of this relationship is the knowing of Jesus. He knows his sheep.
- IV. This will get you killed. I and the Father one.
- V. He returns to where it all began. Where he was baptized and sent out into the world. He is going to make more journey to Jerusalem, but this will end in his death.
