Minister: . . . Let us ascend to the heavenly city in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit!

Congregation: Amen.

Minister: The grace and peace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you!

Minister: Hallelujah! Christ is risen.

Congregation: The Lord is risen indeed. Hallelujah!

SIN OFFERING: CONFESSION

The congregation is invited to kneel.

Unison: Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

Minister: Our Lord Jesus was delivered over because of our transgressions, and was raised because of our justification; those who deny this will perish in their sins, but beloved brethren, believe this and live, therefore as a minister of the Good News of the Resurrection, I declare that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

Congregation: Thanks be to God. Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen.

Minister: Arise, lift up your heads and hear the good news! Christ has purchased your redemption with His own blood! Therefore, stand in His presence, knowing He was raised.

Minister: Hallelujah! Christ our Passover has been sacrificed for us; therefore let us keep the feast, Not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. Hallelujah! Christ being raised from the dead will never die again.

Congregation: Death no longer has dominion over him. Hallelujah!

Minister: So also consider yourselves dead to sin, and alive to God in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Congregation: Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. Hallelujah!

Minister: For since by a man came death, by a man has also come the resurrection of the dead.

Congregation: For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. Hallelujah!

The Sursum Corda

Minister: Lift up your hearts.

Congregation: We lift them up unto the Lord.

Minister: Let us give thanks unto our Lord God.

Congregation: It is good and right so to do.

Minister: It is truly good, right, and salutary, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to you, holy Lord, Almighty Father, Everlasting God. But chiefly are we bound to praise

you for the glorious Resurrection of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord: for he is the very Paschal Lamb, which was offered for us, and has taken away the sins of the world; who by his death he has destroyed death, and by his rising to life again he has restored to us everlasting life. Therefore with Angels and Archangels, and with all the company of heaven, we laud and magnify thy glorious Name; evermore praising thee, and saying:

Congregation: Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of hosts, heaven and earth are full of thy glory: Glory be to thee, O Lord most High. Amen.

The Sign of Peace - *The peace of Christ to you.*

The Bread

Minister: For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Blessed are you, Lord God, King of the Universe who gives seed to the sower and bread to the eater (Is. 55:11). Through your goodness we have received this bread, which the earth has given and human hands have made, and through Your surpassing mercy You have given us this the bread of life. Blessed be God for ever. Amen.

This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

The Wine

Minister: Blessed are you, Lord God, King of the Universe who brings forth food from the earth and wine which makes the heart of man glad (Psalm 104:14-15). Through your goodness we have received this wine, fruit of the vine and work of human hands, and through Your surpassing mercy You have given us this the blood of Your son. Blessed be God for ever. Amen.
