CONFESSTION OF THE NICENE CREED (Please Remain Standing)

We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.







Sermon text: *Colossians 3:1-11*
Sermon Outline: *Risen With Christ*

Outline:

In the Epistle to the Colossians Paul is seeking to present his hearers mature in Christ. He is laboring to teach and equip them to live out faithful lives in the midst of a sinful world. For Paul the center of faithful living is Jesus Christ. The Colossians lives are hidden with Christ in God. They have also died and been raised with Jesus. The Colossians therefore must put off the old man that has died, and put on the new man. The new man is alive in Christ, and is renewed in his image, so that the life the Colossians live is one of faithfulness.
